# Northwest HVAC/R Emergency Health & Safety Plan

## In Case of an Accident:

1. For any significant health emergency and/or doubt about life safety, dial 911.

2. First aid kits are located in the hands-on lab break area and the administrative office break area with posted First Aid signs.

Airway: clear and maintain open airways

3. First Aid & CPR- Think A-B-C

Breathing: restore breathing

Circulation: restore circulation

All accidents need to be immediately reported to the instructor and Training Coordinator. An accident and/or incident report form will be filled

### In Case of Fire:

- 1. For any significant health emergency and/or doubt about life safety, dial 911.
- 2. Fire extinguishers are marked & located throughout the hands-on lab, in each classroom, office hallway and in the administrative office.
- 3. The hands-on lab, classrooms and office areas are equipped with smoke alarms and heat sensors. If sirens go off, vacate the building immediately.

## In Case of Evacuation of the Building:

- 1. Evacuation routes are clearly posted near each door. Choose the nearest exist that is safe and evacuate the building in a safe and orderly fashion.
- 2. Leave all personal belongings- don't jeopardize your safety.
- 3. If you evacuated through the lab doors, if possible continue vacating the fenced backyard through one of the front gates and enter into the street.

Meet at the Salvation Army parking lot across the street, following evacuation. Do not leave until instructed.

### In Case of Violent Attack:

- 1. Get to the nearest safe place that offers protective cover. \*Exit the building if you can safely.
- 2. Call 911 immediately. Wait for the police and do not interfere.

Proactive is better than a reactive.

If you are aware of any persons on campus with a weapon, notify any instructor or administrative staff. Do not try to handle any situation by yourself.
