

**STUDENT CONDUCT RULES**  
**WAC-132Q-02-040**



Students are responsible for knowing and obeying the published rules and regulations of the training center. The following actions are violations of the NW HVAC/R Training Center Student Conduct Code and can result in reprimand, probation, suspension and/or dismissal.

1. Academic dishonesty or concealment thereof, to include the use of cell phones, electronic devices, falsifying time-in and time-out on attendance sheets, and other means for dis-honest purposes.
2. Possessing, consuming or being under the influence of alcoholic beverages and/or any controlled substance and/or paraphernalia in or around classrooms, hands-on lab or elsewhere on school property or internships.
3. Use of profanity or wearing clothing that exhibits profanity in or around classrooms, hands-on lab or elsewhere on school property or internships.
4. Vandalism (including graffiti) or theft in or around classrooms, vending machines, hands-on lab or elsewhere on school property or internships.
5. Failing to observe safety regulations in designated areas.
6. Verbal or physical threatening of others, including any form of sexual or racial harassment towards other students, instruction or administration staff.
7. Possessing firearms, explosives, ammunition or weapons of any kind around classrooms, hands-on lab or elsewhere on school property and internships, including the premises, and parking lot.
8. Failing to abide by all other posted and published school regulations.
9. Solicitation of any kind is prohibited on school property without pre-approval from the Administration.

Violations of the Student Conduct Code will make the violator liable for reprimand, probation, suspension, or dismissal depending upon the seriousness of the violation. All students in violation or suspected to be in violation of Student Conduct rules may be subject to immediate alcohol and drug testing or dismissal from the program. Such a decision may be appealed in writing by the student and submitted to the Executive Director.

Such a decision may be appealed in writing by the student. The School Board will be the final ruling on all Student Conduct Code violations.
