

Northwest HVAC/R Training Center Safe Practices

The HVAC/R Training Center requires safe practices and proper use of equipment at all times to help prevent injury.

I understand there are certain risks involved in this training program and the HVAC/R industry due to; moving parts, operating machinery, cutting sheet metal, brazing pipe and use of torches, handling of refrigerants, diagnostics of equipment while in operation, debris in air during certain tasks, climbing of ladders, hoisting of equipment, sharp tools, electrical shock hazards, use of oil products and equipment, high pressure gases, and other situations that are involved within the learning, troubleshooting, maintaining, installing and servicing of HVAC/R equipment.

I understand that safety glasses will be worn at all times in the lab, even if I am not participating on a project, or walking through to outside or another part of the building. In addition, no shorts, open toed shoes, baggy clothing, jewelry, dark tinted glasses, tank tops or other objects that could jeopardize my safety will be worn in the lab.

I acknowledge these potential risks and will use safe work practices at all times and abide by all rules and procedures that are posted and/or given to me while in the school facility and on company internships.

Smoking is prohibited in the lab and building, this includes e-cigarettes, vapors and chewing tobacco. Discarded chewing tobacco is prohibited in the classroom and lab trash cans, please dispose of in your vehicle or elsewhere.

No running or horse-play allowed in the building or lab.

Any injury must be immediately reported to an HVAC/R instructor, facilitator, or administrative staff. All injuries are required to have an accident report completed and drug and alcohol testing may be required.

Unsafe practices will make the violator liable for reprimand, probation, suspension, or dismissal depending upon the seriousness of the violation.
